

Information regarding the processing of personal data pursuant to Articles 13 and 14 of European Regulation No. 16/679 and subsequent amendments.

1. DATA CONTROLLER

REPERTOR.IO, Tax Code and VAT No. 13291660010, in the person of its legal representative pro tempore, with registered office in Torino, via Quarello, no 15/a is the Data Controller of personal data (hereinafter also “Company”).

The Company is the owner of the platform called Repertor.io at the following link [Repertor.io](https://repertor.io) (hereinafter also the “Platform”).

DATA SUBJECT TO PROCESSING

Personal data being processed means any information that concerns you and that can be traced back to you.

The data that the company intends to process are:

- ✓ Personal data: name, surname, email address, occupation, accounting and banking data.

2. PURPOSE, LEGAL BASIS OF THE TREATMENT AND RETENTION PERIOD

The processing of your personal data is aimed at managing the contractual relationship established when you accept the Platform's terms and conditions.

In particular, your data will be processed for the following purposes:

- a) *exchange information aimed at the execution of the contractual relationship, including pre- and post-contractual activities, including assistance activities.*

THE processing is based on the following legal basis: execution of the contract pursuant to art. 6 par. 1 lett. b) EU Reg. 16/679.

- b) *Enter into and execute the contractual relationship.*

THE processing is based on the following legal basis: execution of the contract pursuant to art. 6 par. 1 lett. b) of EU Regulation 16/679.

- c) *Carry out obligations required by law, Community legislation, as well as to comply with provisions issued by public authorities authorised to do so or by supervisory and control bodies to which the company is subject (for example, tax audits, etc.).*

THE processing is based on the following legal basis: legal obligation deriving from national legislation pursuant to art. 6 par. 1 lett. c) EU Regulation 16/679.

- d) *Exercise and defend the Data Controller's rights in any court, including judicial, administrative, arbitration, and/or mediation and conciliation proceedings.*

THE processing is based on the following legal basis: legitimate interest of the data controller pursuant to art. 6, paragraph 1, letter f) of EU Regulation 16/679.

3. NATURE OF THE PROVISION OF PERSONAL DATA

The provision of data, with regard to the aforementioned purposes, is necessary for the data for which there is a legal obligation and for the data necessary for the execution of the contract in question and any refusal to process your data will make it impossible to execute the contract itself and/or to execute the legal obligations to which the Data Controller is subject.

4. METHODS OF TREATMENT

Within the scope of the purposes indicated above, your data will be processed using paper media as well as IT/electronic tools. In compliance with the regulatory provisions regarding the processing of personal data, adopting appropriate security measures.

Your data will be processed by authorized, specially trained and instructed personnel to ensure adequate security and confidentiality, as well as to avoid risks of loss and/or destruction and access by unauthorized parties. The Company has implemented adequate security measures to protect your personal and business and/or commercial data.

5. COMMUNICATION AND DATA TRANSFER

Your personal data, taking into account the type of contract in place, may be communicated to the subjects authorised to access them by virtue of provisions of law, regulations, community legislation as well as to credit institutions and law firms for the purpose of providing legal advice. Your Data may also be communicated to subjects specifically appointed as external data controllers, such as accountants, companies providing IT and management services, cloud provider. Your data will not be transferred outside the European Union.

6. DIFFUSION

The personal data you provide will not be disclosed without prior authorization.

7. RIGHTS OF INTERESTED PARTIES

As the data subject, you may exercise at any time the rights expressly granted to you by the European Regulation, in particular:

✓ **The right of access to personal data (art. 15 Reg. 16/679)** in order to obtain confirmation from the data controller as to whether or not personal data concerning him or her is being processed, and, where that is the case, to obtain access to the personal data and the following information:

- the purposes of the processing;
- the categories of personal data concerned;
- the recipients or categories of recipients to whom the personal data have been or will be disclosed, in particular recipients in third countries or international organisations;
- where possible, the envisaged period for which the personal data will be stored, or, if not possible, the criteria used to determine that period;
- the existence of the right of the data subject to request from the data controller rectification or erasure of personal data or restriction of processing of personal data concerning him or her or to object to such processing;
- the right to lodge a complaint with a supervisory authority;
- where the personal data are not collected from the data subject, any available information as to their source;
- the existence of an automated decision-making process, including profiling referred to in Article 22, paragraphs 1 and 4 of Regulation 16/679, and, at least in such cases, significant information on the logic used, as well as the importance and the envisaged consequences of such processing for the data subject
- of the existence of adequate guarantees pursuant to Article 46 relating to the transfer of data abroad;

✓ **the right to rectification (art. 16 Reg. 16/679)** and to integrate inaccurate or incomplete personal data concerning you;

✓ **the right to erasure (art. 17 Reg. 16/679)** of your personal data if:

- they are no longer necessary in relation to the purposes for which they were collected or otherwise processed or are processed unlawfully or must be deleted in order to fulfil a legal obligation under Union or Member State law to which the controller is subject;
- they have been collected in relation to the offer of information society services referred to in Article 8, paragraph 1 of Regulation 16/679;
- withdraw consent and, where there is no other legal basis for the processing, object to the processing pursuant to Article 21, paragraph 1 of Regulation 16/679, and there is no overriding legitimate reason to proceed with the processing, or object to the processing pursuant to Article 21, paragraph 2;

✓ **the right to limit the processing of personal data (art. 18 Reg. 16/679)** when one of the following hypotheses occurs:

- You contest the accuracy of the personal data, for a period enabling the data controller to verify the accuracy of the personal data;
- The processing is unlawful and you oppose the erasure of the personal data and request instead that their use be limited even though the data controller no longer needs them for the purposes of the processing, the personal data are required by the data subject for the establishment, exercise or defence of legal claims
- You object to the processing pursuant to Article 21, paragraph 1, pending the verification whether the legitimate grounds of the data controller override your interests.

✓ **the right to portability of personal data (art. 20 Reg. 16/679)** or to transmit such data to another data controller if this is based on consent or a contract;

✓ **right to object (art. 21 Reg. 16/679)** at any time, for reasons related to his particular situation, to the processing of his data concerning him;

- ✓ **revoke consent**
- ✓ **The right to lodge a complaint with a supervisory authority.**
